## MARKET OVERVIEW

### Smart eco-lodge systems are moving from standalone energy meters to integrated property-automation platforms.

Smart eco-lodge systems are moving from standalone energy meters to integrated property-automation platforms. Demand is driven by energy-cost pressure, hospitality decarbonisation pledges and guest expectations for visible sustainability. The market is read two ways — value and units (installations / rooms managed), with rooms-managed penetration as a maturity lens — forecast under conservative, base, accelerated and disruption scenarios, every projection resolved to the 2025 base year and each region reported separately rather than folded into Rest of World.

- Europe leads efficient hospitality, anchored by energy-efficiency rules, eco-certification demand and mature building-management adoption.
- Asia Pacific is the growth engine, with resort expansion across Southeast Asia and the Pacific pairing tourism growth with efficiency drives.
- North America scales on cost and brand, where hotel-group sustainability targets and energy savings drive room-automation uptake.
- System and application segment the value, across energy management, room controls and water systems, and across monitoring, automation and guest-experience use.

## REGIONAL OUTLOOK

Across the seven reporting regions, the report separates deployment leaders from high-growth and emerging markets, profiling named country sub-markets, policy regimes and project pipelines in each. Latin America, Africa and the Middle East are assessed on their own merits — never aggregated into Rest of World — and every forecast resolves to the 2025 base year.
